Even so, this is still a reasonable cost for a venue. The drawback is that only catered food can be in the room, but there are big spaces elsewhere in the building for bring-in food.

The schedule will be about the same as last year:

Friday at the studio, 7:30-10

Saturday in the UMC, room 235, 9-12, 2-5pm, and 7:30-11pm dance party

Sunday at the studio?, 10:30-1:30 review.

Each event will be \$10, except the dance party at \$7. Syllabus \$2. There will be a discount for advance registration, with some sort of refund policy. Parking will be available at Uni Hill Elementary, across Broadway. Ilana will alert the security guards, but we won't pay the actual outrageous rental fee for parking. Ilana will get the workshop listed in the Boulder Weekly, and Biz will cover the Colorado Daily and campus postings.

### Other News

A few tapes have gone missing, so we need to publicize the tape checkout procedures. There is a checkout sheet in the box, and a board member needs to be notified.

Programmers should be aware of their traditional duties to open the studio and help the teacher with tapes, and see that the studio is cleaned up before closing. Everybody else
